According to the Rules of Criminal Procedure (RCr 3.02, 3.05, and 8.01), the arraignment of individuals whose case has been submitted directly to the grand jury shall take place within a reasonable time after the return of an indictment. If you are interested in a case that has been submitted directly to the grand jury, then please contact the court division in which it has been assigned to obtain the time and date of the arraignment.

**SIGNIFICANT EVENTS**

**Dejuan Alexander - 14CR2690** (Kidnapping, Robbery in the First Degree, Sodomy in the First Degree, Rape in the First Degree)

- Mr. Alexander (DOB 3/23/93) on June 14, 2016, in Division 12, entered into a guilty plea to all charges. On November 28, 2011, he had approached a female in

the parking lot of the Speedway at 8325 Preston Highway and forced her into her car at gunpoint, sitting behind her. While still pointing a gun at her, he told her to drive to Chase Bank on Preston Highway and withdraw money. He then forced her to drive to 8000 Preston Highway, climbed into the front passenger seat, put the gun to her head, forced her to perform oral sodomy on him and then vaginally raped her. The case was without a suspect until Mr. Alexander was convicted on other charges and his DNA entered into the CODIS system; a match to the DNA in the rape kit was made in 2014, and this prosecution commenced. After hearing his plea, the Court sentenced him to a term of fifteen years. Elizabeth Jones Brown was the prosecutor.

### **PRETRIAL CONFERENCES**

**Christopher L. McCullum – 15CR0968** (Murder, Wanton Endangerment in the First Degree, Tampering with Physical Evidence)

- Mr. McCullum (DOB 2/21/72) is charged in connection with the February 21, 2015, shooting death of Mukhtar Ahmad on I-71. A pre-trial conference is scheduled on Wednesday, June 22, 2016, at 8:30 a.m. in Division Seven of the Jefferson Circuit Court. Ryan Olberding is the prosecutor.

**Michael Amos Connard - 15CR1985** (Assault in the Second Degree While Wearing Body Armor, Assault in the Second Degree, Possession of a Handgun by a Convicted Felon While Wearing Body Armor [Two Counts], Wanton Endangerment in the First Degree, Wanton Endangerment in the First Degree While Wearing Body Armor, Impersonating a Peace Officer [Two Counts])

- Mr. Connard (4/7/88) allegedly, on June 22, 2015, assaulted victim Donta Johnson. The defendant approached Mr. Johnson, and identified himself as a federal agent. He then pulled out a handgun and accused Mr. Johnson of damaging his car. During the offense, the defendant was wearing a badge around his neck. He then shoved Mr. Johnson into a fence and then onto the ground. The defendant then held a handgun to Mr. Johnson's side until eventually fleeing. As a result of the assault, Mr. Johnson sustained an injury to his left temple. A short time later, while wearing body armor, the defendant approached Mr. Jonathan Shelton and struck Mr. Shelton in the head with a handgun. During the assault, the defendant again displayed a badge identifying himself as a federal agent. The defendant then pointed a handgun at Mr. Shelton. The defendant then holstered the handgun, and produced a second handgun from his left pocket which he used to strike Mr. Shelton in the head, causing a severe laceration. The Defendant was detained and during a pat down for additional weapons a second semi-auto pistol was found in his left pocket as well as a lock blade knife in his right pocket. The Defendant also had 2 tactical flashlights on his persons. A pre-trial conference is set for Wednesday, June 22, at 9:30 a.m. in Division Two. Nick Mudd is the prosecutor.

**Keith Mario Reed- 16CR0837** (Murder)

- Mr. Reed (DOB 4/11/62) is charged in connection with the stabbing death of Mr. Byron Knott on March 24, 2016. The stabbing occurred in front of 2006 Garland Avenue. A pretrial conference is scheduled for Friday, June 24, 2016, at 8:30 a.m. in Division 3. Ryan Olberding is the prosecutor.

**George T. Slaughter- 16CR0409** (Murder [Three Counts]), Possession of a Handgun by a Convicted Felon, Tampering with Physical Evidence)

- Slaughter (DOB 10/16/89) is charged in the February 13, 2016 shooting deaths of Douglas Weber, Elizabeth Draper, and William Neal at 4222 Wheeler Avenue. A Pretrial Conference is scheduled to take place Friday, June 24, 2016, at 9:15 a.m. in Division Three. Erin McKenzie is the prosecutor.

**Damien Lacambra - 16CR1175** (Murder)

- Mr. Lacambra (DOB 3/20/94) is charged with one count of Murder. Mr. Lacambra is accused of shooting his wife, Amelia Lacambra, resulting in her death. A pretrial conference is scheduled for Tuesday, June 21, 2016 at 1:00 p.m. in Division 8. Adrienne Henderson is the prosecutor.

**Antoine Montrell Bosley, Sr. - 14CR2702** (Murder [Domestic Violence], Abuse of a Corpse, Tampering with Physical Evidence [Two Counts], Possession of a Handgun by a Convicted Felon, Possession of a Firearm by a Convicted Felon, and Unauthorized Use of a Vehicle-first offense.)

- Mr. Bosley (DOB 10/22/67) Mr. Bosley allegedly shot his girlfriend, Amy Ndao, and then burned her body in an attempt to conceal evidence of the crime. A pretrial conference is scheduled for Wednesday, June 22 at 10:00 am in Div. 4. Adrienne Henderson is the prosecutor.

**HEARINGS**

**Matthew Epperson - 15CR0704** (Robbery in the First Degree [Five Counts])

- Mr. Epperson (DOB 12/16/91) is charged with robbing of an employee of the Thornton's at 9400 Westport Road on December 16, 2014, an employee of the Speedway at 9416 Shelbyville Road on December 23, 2014, and an employee of the Circle K at 9901 Lagrange Road on December 24, 2014, all at gunpoint, and then an employee of the Circle K at 9737 Third Street Road on December 26, 2014, and an employee of the Speedway at 4547 Taylorsville Road on December 28, 2014, both at knifepoint. He is scheduled to enter a guilty plea to the charges on June 21, 2016, in Division 2. Elizabeth Jones Brown is the prosecutor.
